The organizers pay all the costs of accomodation in 3 stars hotel Lito (about 3 km from the Lasithi prefecture capital city of Agios Nikolaos) and board from October 7th till 14th, 2009, transport from te airport in Heraklion and to the airport in Heraklion and two excursions to the participans with a paper.

All these expenses will be covered maximally to 40 participants with the paper.

In the case that more colleagues will be interested to take part, the organizers will prefer the regular participants of the tactically organised Early Bronze Age meetings, the Early Bronze Age experts, or the colleagues with papers, which will present evident contribution to the topic. Other colleagues will have posibility to take part with their own expenses.

In the case of more co-authors the costs will be covered to the main autor only (look the application form).

The expenses for the co-authors or the colleagues without paper are 50 Euro per day (= 400 Euro for 7 days incl. conference fee). Deposit 200,- Euro must be covered untill May 31th 2009. More information (account Nr. etc.) will be given to the interested participants individually after March 31th, 2009.

The papers cannot be longer than 20 minuts.

The prentations will be accepted only in .ppt (Powerpoint) format.

Conference fee (50 Euro) will be collected upon registration.

The travel agency "Minoan summer" and the Consulate of Czeck Republic in Heraklion, which ensure our accomodation, board and all transports, offer the air tickets from Prague to Heraklion and back in cca 230,- Euro in the case of common transfer of the conference participants. The air tickets will be paid by the participants until May 30th, 2009 to the organizers bank counts (look the preliminary air tickets order).

Transport of the participants from Heraklion to the hotel and from hotel to Heraklion airport will be free for the participants who will travel by this fly.
