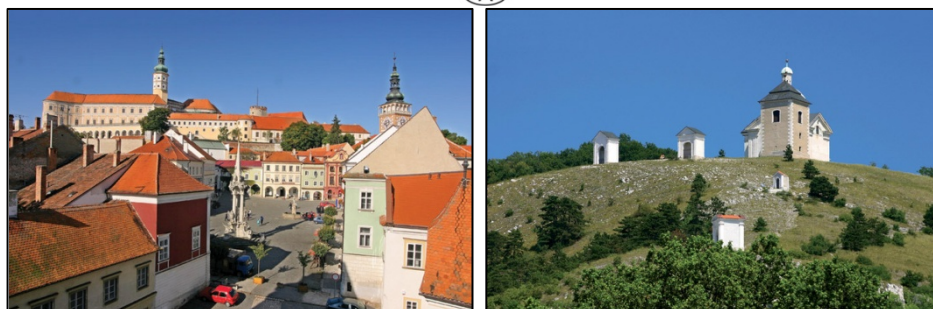

- **Abstract** of the presentation (oral, poster) may be typed directly to the application form. The book of abstract will be available at the registration. Instructions for writing abstract are included in the application form.
- PowerPoint **presentation** must be prepared in English language and performed in Czech, Slovak, Polish or English language. Conference presentations will be held in two parallel thematic sessions.
- **Conference halls** will be equipped with a computer and data projector.
- **Accommodation** will be booked for participants directly in the place of the conference – hotel Eliška^{***}. There are offered single rooms Economy (700 CZK/night), double rooms Economy (1000 CZK/night; i.e. 500 CZK/person/night), single rooms Standard+ (1000 CZK/night) and double rooms Standard+ (1450 CZK/night; i.e. 725 CZK/person/night).
