"Keys to the thoughts of Comenius in our time".

In many ways the world Comenius lived in is comparable to our world today. Religious conflicts, new knowledge brought by research and scientific discoveries, national versus international focus in politics, economic crises with a growing gap between the wealthy and the poor: All these problems were familiar to Comenius. In which way can we compare his 17th century views to modern self concepts and world views? Which of his key ideas about family, school, church and state are applicable to contemporary issues in education, science, society, politics and philosophy?



The locations of the Comenius Conference are the old City Hall (CH) (1) and the Comenius Museum (CM) (2) in Naarden and the Huis met de Hoofden (3) and the Bibliotheca Philosophica Hermetica (4) in Amsterdam. The paper presentations and conversation will be in English or German.
