
In this section, the aim is to highlight the risks associated with mining activities, prevention and solutions to these issues

EXCURSION

It also serves as a professional demonstration of postmining - the transformation of a former mining site into a tourist destination. Due to the difficulty of the underground, this excursion is not suitable for participants with limited mobility.
