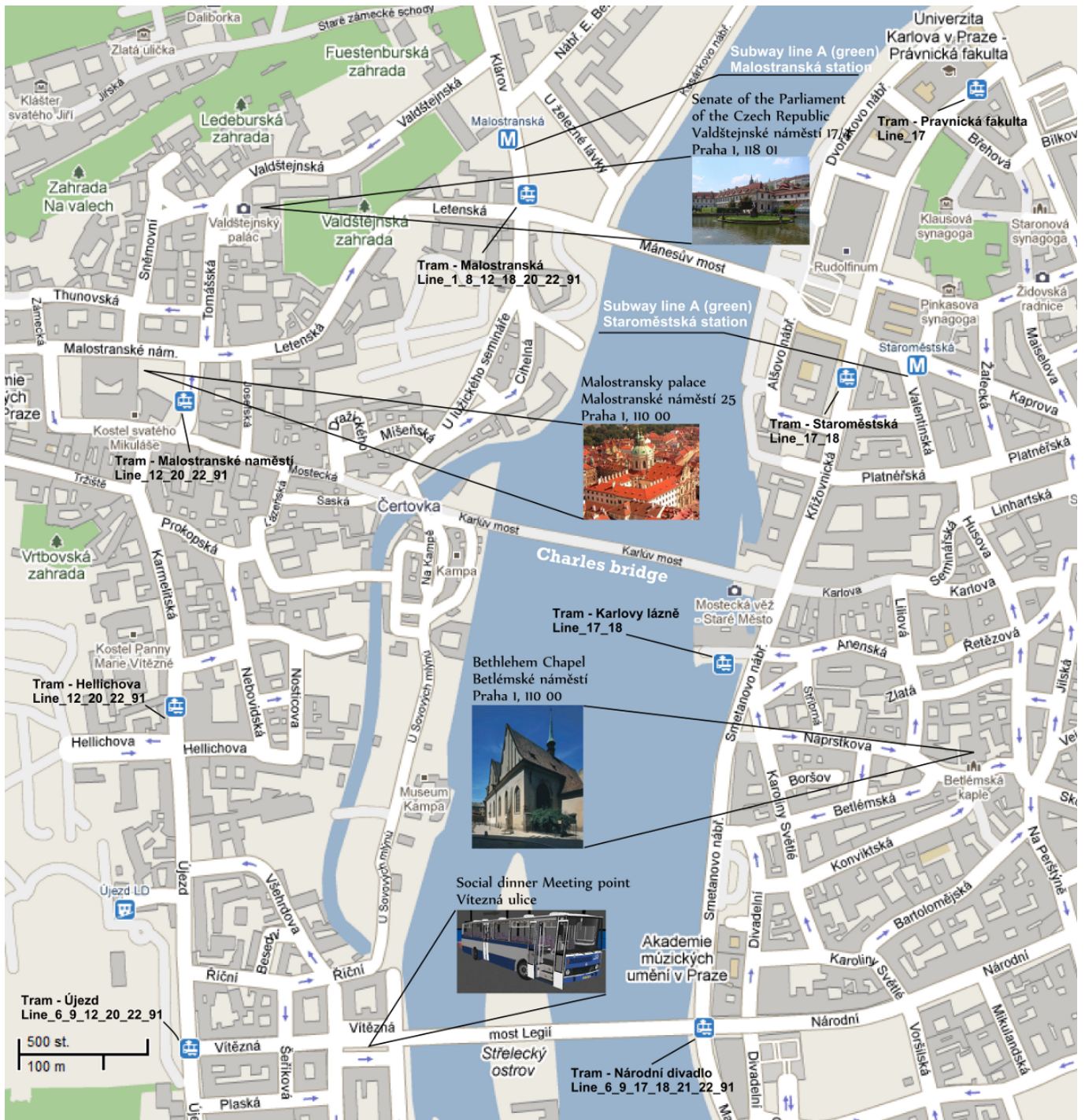


Howto in Prague

brief list of information useful on arrival to Prague

- ※ The hotels and conference venue on Mala Strana can be best reached by taxi from the airport. It shall not cost more than 30EUR.
- ※ Alternatively, It is possible to take bus 119 in front of the airport go to terminus change to metro line A, get off at Malostranska station and follow the map below.
- ※ 7 days Prague city transport ticket is included in conference materials.
- ※ Prague is a very safe city, nevertheless, when walking mainly in the area near Charles Bridge, Old City Square and Prague Castle one has to care about pick pockets , please keep your valet and ID safe. Emergency call center – 112.
- ※ Please bring a laptop, conference proceedings are already available on the www.esomat.org.
- ※ Join Welcome event on Sunday evening 6PM September 6 in Malostransky palace.
- ※ On Monday September 7, the conference starts on 8.30 by keynote lectures in Bethlehem Chapel.

- ※ Local currency - Czech crown (CZK), Exchange rate on September 2, 2009: 1€ ~ 26CZK / 1\$ ~ 18CZK.

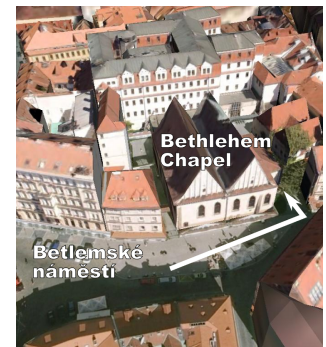
Malostranský palace

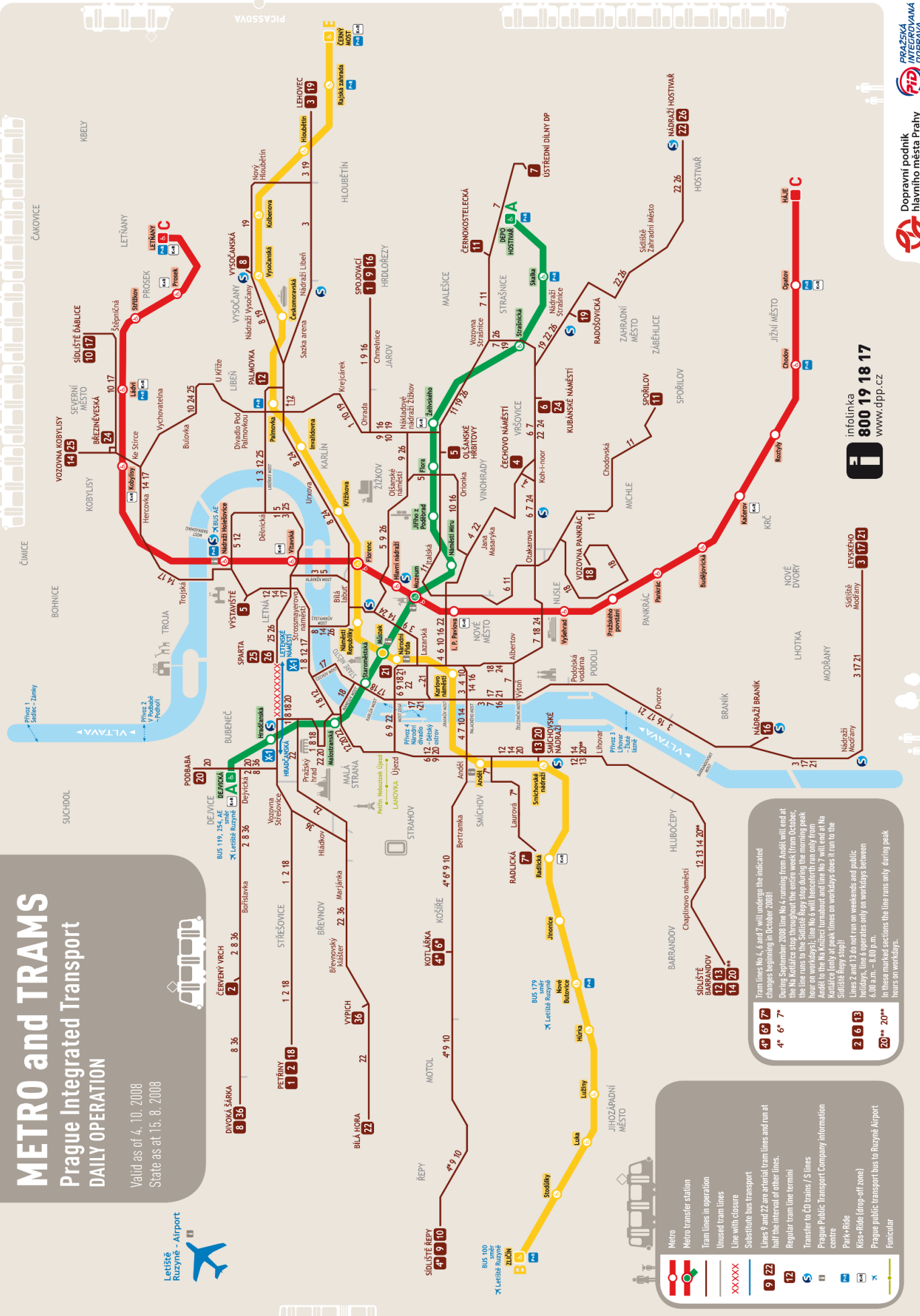

Tram lines No. 4, 6 and 7 will undergo the indicated changes beginning in October 2008:

Line No. 7 will end at the Letná station on weekdays.
