Loan conditions

- 1. Loans must be returned by the date specified on the loan form. Specimens are lent initially for two months; requests for extention of the loan period must be made in writing to the curator of the collection, well before the date for return of the loan.
- 2. All specimens must be maintained and returned in the same preservative in which they were sent.
- 3. Material on loan remains the responsibility of the borrower and must <u>not</u> be transferred to another worker or removed from the institution specified on the loan form without prior permission.
- 4. Specimens may not be dissected, stained, or altered in any other way without prior permission. All preparations made from them must be returned in the usual way.
- 5. Students, and others not in permanent employment, will only receive loans in the name of their supervisors who will be held responsible for the safe keeping and return of the material.
- 6. All labels must be kept with the specimens and returned with them. Type specimens selected from loan material should be clearly labelled as such.
- 7. Loans returned by post should be securely packed, registered or insured as appropriate and wherever possible should be sent by airmail to avoid delay.
- 8. The conditions set out here will be strictly applied and failure to comply may result in the loss of borrowing privileges.
