Purpose of the Job

ESO runs an Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system based on Microsoft Dynamics NAV. Further components of the ERP infrastructure are a document management system from COI as well as a Cognos TM1 OLAP database. In order to strengthen its ERP Group ESO is seeking for an ERP consultant for user support and training, system maintenance, specifications and new developments.

Responsibilities and Working Environment

The successful candidate will be a member of the ERP Service Group in the Administration Division. She/he will report to the Head of the ERP Group and closely work with other Departments within the Administration Division, as well as with all other ERP system users ESO wide.

The main tasks include:

- Participating in analyzing and defining business processes, system requirements and workflows for all ERP components.
- Definition and implementation of new modules, system upgrades and improvements in Microsoft Dynamics NAV, system documentation, and failure analysis.
- Definition, development and implementation of reporting tools based on the existing OLAP database.

- Support and maintenance of the document management system.
- Training and support for users in Garching and Chile.

Qualifications

University degree in Information Technology, Computer Science or equivalent with several years of experience in consulting, development and implementations of Enterprise Resource Planning systems.

Experience

The ideal candidate will have knowledge and experience in Microsoft Dynamics NAV system specifications, implementations and development. Working knowledge in one or more of the other ERP system components is an asset.

Key Competences

The position requires a working knowledge of English, and good knowledge of MS Office applications. Good analytical and organizational skills as well as interpersonal and communication skills are essential.

Duty Station: Garching near Munich, Germany with regular duty trips to all ESO sites in Chile.
