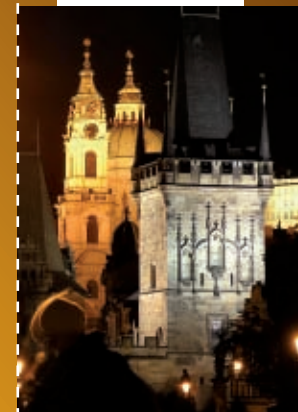

PERMEA MEETING

A new era of international membrane meetings PERMEA started as the initiative of membranologists from the Visegrad countries (Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia) in Tatranske Matliare in 2003. The next biennial conferences found a high rating in the membrane community. Czech Republic became the fourth Visegrad country organizing PERMEA 2009.

SCOPE

Membrane processes find use as a part of many technological applications and also in daily activities of people. The meeting will give an insight into membrane preparation and their use as separation techniques and will be focused especially on renewable sources. The electrochemical processes and presentation of new ideas in ion exchange applications will be of particular interest.



TOPICS

- Electromembrane processes, ion exchange membranes, electrodialysis, electrodeionization, membrane electrolysis
- Hybrid membrane processes, power technologies
- Membrane separation methods, technological equipment
- Membrane materials, membrane preparation and characterization
- Transport across membranes, mathematical models

PROGRAMME

The scientific programme will consist of keynote lectures of 30 min (including discussion) and short lectures of 20 min (including discussion) on all the topics. The lectures will be supplemented by a panel discussion to assess the current state and the needs for future research in membrane science.

Those participants who wish to present lecture should submit a brief summary to the Secretariat before **31 December 2008**.

At the end of January 2009, the Programme Committee will select the lectures and the authors will be notified whether their contribution is accepted for oral presentation.

PUBLICATION

Summaries of lectures will be published in the **Programme Booklet** provided that they have been registered and their camera-ready text reached the Secretariat by **31 March 2009**.
