



ROZELA

(UEB 3322/5) was produced by crossing Vanda with Bohemia
Community Plant Variety Rights EU 22308 from 05. 05. 2008

- Tree:** Diploid, spreading growth habit with weak to medium vigour, produces many fruiting spurs
- Blossom:** Early to mid-season, flowers heavily and regularly
- Picking time:** End September, about one week before Golden Delicious, eating maturity 2 weeks after picking
- Productivity:** Precocious, annual producer of heavy crops
- Keeping quality:** In natural storage until March
- Fruit:** Medium to large, round to flat-round, slightly irregularly ribbed in the eye basin, attains 90 % attractive red blush over yellow groundcolour, appears russet free. Prominent lenticels, stem medium. Flesh yellowish, medium firm, crisp, juicy, sweet with little acid, good aromatic flavour
- Diseases:** Resistant to scab (Vf), tolerant to mildew
- Comment:** Grower-friendly variety for organic fruit production with an intensive growing system, appears to be better adapted to cooler apple producing areas. Rozela is licensed to V.NL (Stichting Vermeerderingstuinen Nederland 5961 NK Horst) and to Fytos CZ-30117 Plzeň
