

SHALIMAR

(UEB 3374/2) was produced by crossing Topaz with Golden Delicious

Community Plant Variety Rights EU 25472 from 22. 06. 2009

Origin: Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Strizovice), CZ

Tree: Diploid, medium vigour, ramified, spreading growth habit,

Blossom: Mid-season, flowers heavily and regularly

Picking time: Middle to end October, about two weeks after Golden Delicious, eating maturity

since January

Productivity: Precocious, annual producer of heavy crops

Keeping quality: In natural storage until April

Fruit: Medium size, shape conical, stem medium long, skin smooth, free of russet,

yellow green to yellow ground color is covered with about 80 % solid red flesh and weakly defined stripes, flesh is yellowish, firm, crisp, juicy, with high and

harmonic sugar and acid content and very good flavour

Diseases: Resistant to scab (*Vf*), tolerant to mildew

Comment: A late-winter, highly productive, scab resistant apple variety with brightly red

conical fruits, having good keeping quality and good shelf live after storage, suitable especially for warm, sunny apple producing areas.
