## Copyright policy for The Economics Institute of the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic (hereafter, the "EI")

El authors own the copyright to their own works.

The authors themselves request the rights of publication, reproduction, adaptation, distribution, public performance, and public display of the authors' works.

- 1. The author and EI agree that the author's right to publish, reproduce, adapt, distribute, publicly perform, and publicly display his or her work have been agreed within the Act No. 121/2000 Coll., on Copyright, Rights Related to Copyright, and the Amendment of Certain Laws (the Czech Copyright Act).
- 2. The author reserves the right to publish, reproduce, adapt, distribute, publicly perform, and publicly display his or her work, subject to the requirement that the author shall include, in any subsequent publication, reproduction, adaptation, distribution, public performance, and public display of the work, a clear statement that the work was first published by EI, and shall include a corresponding citation to the original EI publication. EI is not bound to the requirement of such a statement.
- 3. The author agrees that EI may edit the work if necessary to suit EI's requirements, but publication is subject to final review and approval by the author.
- 4. El retains the right to authorize the publication, reproduction, adaptation, distribution, public performance, and public display of the work as a contribution of El in electronic media, computerized retrieval systems, and similar forms now available or later developed. Such authorization includes, but is not limited to, use of the work anywhere in the world by means of public display, conversion to print or machine-readable form, and reproductions.
