

(UEB 3264/2) was produced by crossing Golden Delicious with Topaz

Origin: Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Strizovice), CZ

Tree: Diploid, moderately vigorous, spreading, branching dense, fruiting spurs

medium to short

Blossom: Mid-season, slightly before Golden Delicious, flowers heavily with slight

alternance

Picking time: Early October, together with Golden Delicious, only slight fruit thinning appears

to be required, eating maturity 3 weeks after picking

Productivity: Similar to Golden Delicious **Keeping quality:** In natural storage until April

Fruit: Medium, round-conical, height:width ratio 0.90, ribbing very weak, stem

medium, russet in stem cavity, can radiate to side of fruit, skin color yellow to yellow-orange, flesh yellow, firm, fine to medium grained, medium juicy, full

flavored, sweet (15.2 % Brix), mild-subacid, very good

Diseases: Resistant to scab (*Vf*), tolerant to powdery mildew, bitter pit does not occur

Comment: Requires rather an intensive growing system and environmental conditions similar to Golden Delicious, prefers sunny, dry, wine growing

areas with irrigation
