Cataloguing

- Descriptive and subject cataloguing
- ❖ Subject headings → validation glossary (authors, subject terms)

Processed :

- ✓ 12 000 titles of monographs
- ✓ 400 titles of serials
- ✓ 3 000 titles of articles

=source of factual and bibliographic information

=processed from 40's 20 –th century

Specialization :

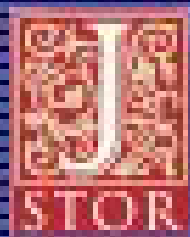
- Bibliography of the Czech archaeologists

- Archaeology related to the Czech rep.

Relevant information to document

For one reader's inquiry
you can obtain :

- document location
- reference to full-text databases
- reference to internet bookshop
- reference to citation database
- more detailed information about document, author via electronic encyclopedia
- link to www browsers
