- Origin: Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Strizovice), CZ
- Tree: Diploid, moderate vigor, compact columnar type
- Blossom: Mid-season, flowers heavily and quite regularly
- **Picking time:** Early to mid-October, about one week after Golden Delicious, eating maturity since November
- **Productivity:** Very precocious, produces nearly regular heavy crops
- Keeping quality: In natural storage until March
- Fruit: Medium, conical to round conical, stem length medium, skin smooth, appears russet free, yellow green ground color, seldom with a slight red-orange blush, flesh yellowish, medium to firm, crisp, fine grained texture, juicy, flavor good, aromatic, well balanced sugar and acid levels

Scab resistant with Vf gene, tolerant to mildew **Diseases:**

A winter, scab resistant, good dessert apple variety with compact columnar Comment: type, good eating and storage qualities, precocious and heavy in bearing, suitable for home gardens and possibly also for commercial dessert apple production and for juice industry **Institute of Experimental** Botany of the AS CR, v. v. i.
