The dual earner/carer model: Norwegian experiences

Abstract:

The talk centres on the Norwegian *dual earner-carer model*, addressing how this model has developed and its effects on family practices and gender equality. It starts with a sketch of some of the historical influences that gender equality ambition have had on this model. Then follows an outline of main policy reforms since the late 1970s that have supported gender equality: parental leave, daddy quotas and childcare services. Also the impact of policies that compete with the gender equality ambition, supporting 'parental choice', the cash for care arrangement for parents not using publicly subsidised childcare, is addressed.

Anne Lise Ellingsæter is Professor of Sociology at the University of Oslo, Norway. Her research interests include gender and work, work-family relations, working time, family policy and fertility.
