



## CACTUS

(UEB 3137/1) is a hybrid between Topaz and Tuscan (Bolero®)

Community Plant Variety Rights EU 30092 from 23.05.2011

- Origin:** Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Střížovice) CZ
- Tree:** Diploid, columnar type, growth weak and very compact, very short internodes
- Blossom:** Mid-season, flowers heavily but without fruit thinning becomes biennial
- Picking time:** Towards end of September
- Productivity:** Very precocious, heavy in the year of cropping, tends to alternate bearing
- Keeping quality:** In natural storage until December
- Fruit:** Size medium, shape globose conical, stem short, skin smooth without russetting, green-yellow color turns to yellow during storage, over color absent, flesh medium firm to soft, fine, very juicy, harmonic sugar/acid ratio, weakly aromatic
- Diseases:** Resistant to scab (Vf), tolerant to mildew
- Comment:** Columnar variety with very interesting unusual very compact habit, suitable for home gardens
