Origin:	Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Strizovice), CZ
Tree:	Diploid, vigorous, compact columnar type
Blossom:	Mid-season
Picking time:	Mid-October, about 10 days after Golden Delicious, eating maturity since November
Productivity:	good, usually requires thinning to produce annual crops
Keeping quality:	In natural storage until March
Fruit:	Large, broad globose to round conical, stem short, skin smooth, appears russet free, green yellow becoming yellow during storage, over color absent, flesh yellowish, firm, crisp, very juicy, with very good aromatic flavor and well balanced sugar and acid levels
Diseases:	Scab resistant with Vf gene, tolerant to mildew
Comment:	A late robust variety with compact columnar tree type, resistant to scab ( <i>Vf</i> ), suitable especially as a good dessert apple for home gardens, its large yellow,

long keeping firm, crisp and very juicy fruits could have potential for juice industry
