Origin: Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Strizovice), CZ

Tree: Diploid, medium vigorous, ramified, upright, good branching

Blossom: Mid-season

Productivity: Early October, with Golden Delicious **Productivity:** Semi-precocious, medium to heavy

Keeping quality: In natural storage until April

Fruit: Medium size, shape conical, height: width ratio 0,92, stem medium long, skin

smooth, appears russet free, ground color green yellow, later yellow, seldom with a slight red-orange blush, flesh yellow, firm, crisp, juicy, well balanced

sugar and acid level, good flavour

Diseases: Resistant to scab (*Vf*), tolerant to mildew

Comment: A winter, yellow, good dessert apple variety with resistance against scab (Vf)

and good storage qualities and shelflife, light thinning is recommended for

regular bearing
