International Scientific Meeting in Cluj

The 300th anniversary of Denis Diderot's (1713–1784) birth is an excellent opportunity to inquire again into problems related to human knowledge, art and tradition, creativity and ethos. An unmistakable writer of theatre plays, dissertations, novels, scientific articles, Diderot was a defining character of the *Encyclopédie*, an art critic and a tireless experimenter whose influence hasn't been fully explored.
