

(UEB 3264/1) is a hybrid Golden Delicious x Topaz

Community Plant Variety Rights EU 23532 from 13. 10. 2008

Origin: Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Strizovice), CZ

Tree: Diploid, medium vigorous, spreading, has long vegetation season, leaves

remain for a long time on trees similarly as in Elstar

Blossom: Mid-season

Picking time: Early October about with Golden Delicious, eating maturity about 2 weeks after

picking

Productivity: Semi-precocious, heavy, does require fruit thinning for regular bearing

Keeping quality: In natural storage until March

Fruit: Size medium to large, shape globose to conical, moderate ribbing, bright yellow

usually without a blush, stem long, skin smooth, slightly waxy and shiny, russet free, flesh yellowish medium firm, crisp, very juicy with sweet-subacid flavour

and good taste

Diseases: Resistant to scab (*Vf*), very low susceptibility to powdery mildew

Comment: A late variety with attractive appearance suitable mainly for home gardens
