The successful applicant will be based in the Institute of Mathematics of the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic in Prague and perform mathematical research in the areas of the project. The applicant is also expected to take part in the activities of the research group of the Institute of Mathematics such as seminars and workshops organized by the group.

Applications are invited from candidates who have completed his/her Ph.D. degree in Mathematics, or Theoretical Computer Science, within the last 4 years (or will complete his/her Ph.D. degree by the end of 2013), and who have good background in proof complexity and computational complexity. Publications, as well as other activities and professional achievements, will be judged by the stage of the applicant's career.
