Copyright policy for The Charles University in Prague, Center for Economic Research and Graduate Education (hereafter, the "UK CERGE")

UK CERGE authors own the copyright to their own works.

The authors themselves request the rights of publication, reproduction, adaptation, distribution, public performance, and public display of the authors' works.

- 1. The author and UK CERGE agree that the author's right to publish, reproduce, adapt, distribute, publicly perform, and publicly display his or her work have been agreed within the Act No. 121/2000 Coll., on Copyright, Rights Related to Copyright, and the Amendment of Certain Laws (the Czech Copyright Act).

- 3. The author agrees that UK CERGE may edit the work if necessary to suit UK CERGE's requirements, but publication is subject to final review and approval by the author.

UK CERGE retains the right to authorize the publication, reproduction, adaptation, distribution, public performance, and public display of the work as a contribution of UK CERGE in electronic media, computerized retrieval systems, and similar forms now available or later developed. Such authorization includes, but is not limited to, use of the work anywhere in the world by means of public display, conversion to print or machine-readable form, and reproductions.
