This year the theme of the conference is:

THE ARCHAEOLOGY OF ANCIENT CULTURAL LANDSCAPE

All possible archaeological components separately and/or together from rural and urban settlements, industrial and religious facilities, resources and communications to burials, supplemented with historical, linguistic and art-historical studies, reveal the way of living and the thinking of ancient populations. Any research or new theoretical approaches can contribute to the creation of innovative interpretations and a shift in our understanding of classical culture.

Conceived broadly, this theme gives young scholars an opportunity to present and discuss their opinions and thoughts applicable to the theme. Papers are welcome from postgraduates in all stages of their research, both theoretical and practical. We believe that this conference will allow participants to meet, collaborate and share their ideas.
