Deadline for abstract submission : **30th of November 2014**

Potential participants are invited to submit to the International Committee and the Scientific Committee an abstract of one page (up to 300 words) with the title of the paper or poster in capital letters, the name and position of the author(s), and a clear indication of whether the presentation will be oral or a poster.
