Suárez and Descartes on the nature of philosophy Prof. Jorge Secada

University of Virginia, Universidad Catolica del Peru

Jorge Secada is Professor of Philosophy at the University of Virginia, where he has taught since 1984. In Spring Term 2014 he was NEH Distinguished Visiting Professor at SUNY College at Potsdam. Starting in 2015 he will also jointly hold a position as Professor of Philosophy at the Catholic University of Peru in Lima. From 1980 to 1984 he was a Fellow at St Johns College in Cambridge. He has published extensively on Descartes, Suarez, and renaissance and early modern philosophy, including a book, Cartesian Metaphysics (Cambridge 2000), and several articles in journals and collections, including the recent "God and Meditation in Descartes' Meditations" (in Detlefsen, Descartes' Meditations: a critical guide, Cambridge 2013) and "Suarez's Nominalist Master Argument" (in Novak, Suarez's Metaphysics, Berlin, 2014). He is currently co-editor for Routledge of The Cartesian Mind, a substantial new collection of essays on the historical background and influence of Descartes (forthcoming in 2018). Secada is also a public figure in his native Peru where he publishes a national newspaper weekly column and is a regular guest commentator on TV.
