The international conference welcomes all Post-graduate researchers in the subject-area of Archaeology, History, Art History, Culture & Religion Studies who are interested in issues related to ancient Egypt (especially Delta region), Cyprus, Levant, Mesopotamia and Persia.

This year the theme of the conference is ancient city, its formation and development. It has been set to focus on the ancient city as a place where people live, as well as the urbanisation process, relations between urban centres, urban ideology etc., in the region called the 'Fertile Crescent', where the first cities were founded.

The presentations will be grouped into several sections according to their focus and should not exceed 20 minutes. The number of active participants is also limited. The conference committee reserves the right to select the contributions to be published in the Conference Proceedings.
