



REDSRING

(UEB 3810/1) is a hybrid Elise with UEB 3300/1

Community Plant Variety Rights EU 34099 from 04. 02. 2013

- Origin:** Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Strizovice), CZ
- Tree:** Diploid, medium vigorous, compact columnar type, narrow habit
- Blossom:** Mid-season, flowers heavily but without fruit thinning becomes biennial
- Picking time:** Early October with Golden Delicious, eating maturity shortly after picking
- Productivity:** Precocious, heavy but usually requires thinning to produce annual crops
- Keeping quality:** In natural storage until end of February
- Fruit:** Medium, conical to round conical, stem length medium, skin smooth, appears russet free, about 80 % blushed bright red on a green yellow background, flesh medium firm, crisp, juicy with fine grained texture, medium and harmonic good flavour
- Diseases:** Scab resistant, carries the *Vf* gene, low susceptibility to powdery mildew
- Comment:** Compact columnar variety producing attractive fruits with eating qualities, precocious produces prone to biennial bearing if crop load is not controlled, requires rather cooler apple producing areas to achieve outstanding colour, the variety is suitable mainly for home gardens as late dessert apple
