

How can I download EBSCO eBooks to an Apple device and read them using the Bluefire Reader app?

This guide is designed for library users who are CERGE-EI members and can use CERGE-EI Wi-Fi or who use remote access. Libairfree Wi-Fi does not allow access to EBSCO eBooks.

- **Before transferring an eBook, you will need the following:**

1. A Valid **AdobeID** - this may be created free at:
https://www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/index.cfm?nf=1&nl=1&loc=en_us
2. A Portable eReader – recommended application for EBSCO eBooks is **Bluefire Reader App** - available free at <http://itunes.apple.com/us/app/bluefire-reader/id394275498?mt=8>

- **Authorize Bluefire App with your Adobe ID**

1. Open the Bluefire app on your Apple device.
2. Go to **“Info.”**
3. Enter your Adobe ID and password in the fields provided.
4. Tap **Authorize**.

- **Checkout and Download an eBook**

at <http://search.ebscohost.com/login.aspx?authtype=ip,uid&profile=ebooks>

1. Run a search on *EBSCOhost*.
2. Tap the **Download (Offline)** link for the eBook you would like to download.
Note: If you are not logged into your personal My *EBSCOhost* folder, you will be prompted to do so.
3. Select a **Checkout period** from the drop-down menu and tap the **Checkout & Download** button.
The eBook will be added.
4. Open the eBook in Bluefire app. on your Apple device.
