The above contracting entity announces the following additional information relating to the tender conditions in accordance with the provisions of sect. 49 of Act No. 137/2006 Coll., on public contract as amended.

Question:

Letter of authorisation – is it permissible for this to be signed by our Managing Director only or do we need to provide wet signatures from all our Board members?

Clause 3.3.1 (i) – In section 3.3.2 it clearly states which clauses from 3.3.1 are covered by each of the documents which are to be provided as evidence. However there is no clarification as to where 3.3.1 (i) is covered. Could you advise what we have to provide to address this clause.

Section 3.3.2 (e) – List of statutory bodies or members of statutory bodies of the applicant that have worked for the client in the past 3 years. We have undertaken work for ELI through the Institute of Physics during this period. Do you require us to give the Company name or do we have to name all the individuals who have worked on the project.

Section 3.4 – Company Registration Document - Is this single document sufficient to satisfy the requirements of both a) and b) of this section. If not could you please clarify what is required.

Answers:


Letter of authorisation - It is not necessary to have the Letter of authorisation signed by all your Board members, it could be signed by your Managing Director if he is authorised to do so.

Clause 3.3.1 (i) – this is only general provision of the Act, and there is no need to provide it by the supplier in the case of this public tender. That's why this clause is not clarified in the clause 3.3.2.

Section 3.3.2 (e) – The List of statutory bodies or members of statutory bodies of the applicant that have worked for the client in the past 3 years - it means that in this list the supplier has to name all the individual members of the statutory bodies who were **employees** of the contracting entity (Institute of Physics) in the past three years.

Clause 3.11 – The Company Registration Document could be sufficient to satisfy the requirements of both a) and b) of the section 3.4, if there are given all the information required in the clause 3.4.
