The above contracting entity announces the following additional information relating to the tender conditions in accordance with the provisions of sect. 49 of Act No. 137/2006 Coll., on public contract as amended.

### **Question:**

In Section 3.3.1 and 3.3.2 the invitation to tender requires that we provide an extract from the Penal Register to confirm that we have no convictions, cautions etc. In a previous submission regarding ELI we provided a police certificate for only one of our board of directors and this was accepted as being sufficient. I am told that in the United Kingdom personnel are only eligible to become directors of a company if they have no convictions and if the company were prosecuted this would be recorded on the police record of each of the company directors. Consequently if we provide a Penal Certificate for one of our directors showing no convictions it is clear that this would apply to all other directors and to company in general.

Can you please confirm if this is acceptable or advise what we must do to ensure that we have satisfied your requirements.

### **Answer:**

The supplier can provide these requirements of Sections 3.3.1 and 3.3.2 by the way it goes in his country, but there must be submitted a solemn declaration as a part of the bid, that this is the correct way according to law of the country.
