## Why do we need to know the context?





- Recommendations expected
- Information needed:
  - » Existing innovative practices
  - » Context of their implementation
  - » Opportunities and barriers
- Description of contextual factors will enable us to indicate conditions that have to be met when introducing specific kinds of practices.
- > => For comparison and recommendations it is necessary to know national contexts.





## What contextual factors play role I.





- Macroeconomic and demographic indicators
  - » Provided by PP3
- Pension system
  - » FQ: Section A Part 1
- Housing system and housing policies
  - » FQ: Section B = Preliminary report
- Welfare model and social care and services system
  - » FQ: Section C
- Legal framework
  - » FQ: Contained in all the parts of the questionnaire





## What contextual factors play role II.





- Housing attitudes of elderly housing and care preferences
  - » Literature review, data accessibility overview
- Elderly's living conditions
  - » Financial situation and housing affordability
    - SHARE and SILC data
  - » How elderly live
    - FQ: Section A Part 2





## Final questionnaire - Section A





- Pension system
  - » Pension system's type and sustainability
  - » Retirement age and incomes of pensioners
- How do elderly live?
  - » Structure of households, who elderly live with
  - » Type of housing and its tenure structure
  - » Living standards
  - » Share of elderly in big towns / cities
