Brewing Ethnicity Revisiting the 1897 Riots and Beer Boycotts in Pilsen

Alison Orton (University of Illinois at Chicago)

The lecture will discuss how self-identified “Czech” rioters who attacked Pilsen’s largest “German” brewery and later boycotters of Pilsen’s breweries used beer as a marker of national belonging – as both a connector and a divider of people. An examination of the riots in Pilsen is a part of my dissertation, which studies beer and the brewing industry as a way to deepen our understanding of the fluidity of nationalist sentiments in the Czech Lands and among migrants from the Czech Lands to the United States.
