The volumes are formally consistent in structure, but the theoretical points of departure, methodological approaches and emphasis on specific subjects reflect the views of the individual editors and teams of authors. In terms of the proportion between the quantity of information and the extent of the territory investigated, the series represents one of the most detailed overviews of prehistory devoted to a particular region. The publication is intended for researchers and students who need basic information on the prehistory of Bohemia, along with detailed documentation and references.
