# Innovative practices in Germany

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# **Community building**

#### **Project:**

#### Together instead of alone. Generation living in Arnstadt-Ost

- Programme: "Innovations for Appropriate Urban Neighbourhoods for Families and Elderly" (BMVBS, 2007-2010): model projects + case studies
- **Initiators:** municipal housing community + urban planning strategists
- Situation: negative migration; ageing citizenship; unattractive housing standards
- Approach: development of more generation concept under active involvement of local citizenship

#### Success:

- Reduction of dwelling units in multi-storey buildings from 72 to 51
- 48 barrier-free and 3 dwellings for strongly disabled people
- community rooms
- common housing project
- neighbourhood café offering services
- contact point that coordinates all activities



## Housing accessibility

#### **Project:**

**Living Age** (Alter Leben)

- Programme: Age-adapted assistance systems for a healthy and independent live (BMBF, 2009-2012)
- Initiator: Housing Association of Saxony
- Aim:
  - Adapt selected dwellings to dynamically changing demands
  - Ensure autonomous at-home-living of elderly people
  - Support and further develop technical solutions and break into new market

#### Approach:

- Develop, test and evaluate modular offers and concepts (AAL, reduction of barriers, diverse services etc.) that
  - are realisable in a medium-term perspective
  - simply operability and subsequent install-ability
- Implement regional networking of partners
- Develop reliable business models
- Launching accompanying research



### **Housing affordability**

#### **Concept:**

Model of Bielefeld (Bielefelder Modell)

 Initiators: local charitable housing association, association for old person assistance and city of Bielefeld

#### Aim:

- Effective and low-cost alternative to assisted living concepts
- Make flats in senior residential complexes attractive for a broad spectrum of elderly and vulnerable people
- Offering and secure diverse services, consultation and common activities without public funded care allowance

#### Idea and approach:

- Bundling of services within the condominium and close, continuous cooperation with care service providers to reduce costs
- No fixed lump-sum allowance but flexible application of the care service
- Support professional service provision with organised help of friends and neighbours
- Use social housing programme to fund rents



#### Social and health care

#### **Concept:**

# SOPHIA – care and service solutions for living in the housing stock

- Initiators: Bavarian Josefstiftung Bamberg with support of the Federal Health Ministry and the Bavarian Social Ministry in 2002; today: private service provider SOPHIA GmbH
- Aim: ensure elderly and vulnerable people an independent live and prevent vacancies in the housing stock

#### Approach:

- Providing assistance and support with an integrated approach involving the SOPHIA GmbH and local partners of the housing sector + local care facilities
- Housing companies can act as franchise partner of the SOPHIA GmbH and provide standardised care services
- Technical equipment and personal contact are central elements
- Several components can be booked (information or education services, regular telephone-calls, shopping services or home delivered meals, mobile care services, technical assistance systems etc.)
- Costs vary between 20 and 40 € per month



#### **Access to information and education**

#### **Consultancy approach:**

#### Hamm: establishment of an education and advice system

- Programme: "Altersgerecht umbauen" (BMVBS, until 2011)
- **Situation:** housing stock from 30's to 70's, currently in reconstruction phase, low level of age-appropriate reconstruction
- Aim: Enhance recognition of private house owners for potentials of age appropriate reconstruction, minimising existing information deficits

#### Approach:

- Establishing new information system providing information on possibilities, challenges and suitable funding solutions
- Transfer of knowledge and experience through education of urban planners, craftsperson, social- and health experts
- Establishment of networks of existing consulting and moderations offers
- Intensive dissemination
- Outputs: monthly "reconstruction roundtables", concept of modular qualification, information seminars etc.
