The Symbolic Codification and Political Role of Collective Performances and Public Rituals in Central Catalonia (Berga, Solsona)

Traditional festivals offered a potent resource for Catalonia's transition to democracy in the late 1970s. They shared flexible repertoires and mediated ideological difference to facilitate collective action. *Festes* as well as other collective/public forms of action (demonstrations, rallies and public protests, *referenda...*) have proliferated since, and the recent Catalan independence movement recruited them again to mobilize public opinion. This time, however, instead of vitalizing *convivencia*, these public rituals and performances have contributed to a misrecognition and a polarization of the wider political environment and debate. What happened?

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
