



Call for Papers: 18th EAA Annual Meeting 2012, Helsinki, Finland, 29 August–1 September

The Eighteenth Annual Meeting of the European Association of Archaeologists will be held in Helsinki, Finland, from 29 August to 1 September, 2012 at the University of Helsinki. The meeting is organised by the University of Helsinki, the National Board of Antiquities, the Finnish Antiquarian Society and the Archaeological Society of Finland.

The Scientific Committee is now inviting submission of abstracts for individual papers. The main themes of this year's meeting are: *Archaeological Heritage Resource Management*, *Interpreting the Archaeological Record*, *Maritime Archaeology* and *Perspectives on Archaeology in the Modern World*.
