Conference topic:

Large-scale excavations of medieval and modern-day sites: Results, methods and processing of archaeological finds from towns, villages and castles

The aim of this year's conference is to incite a wider discussion about the results and processing of finds from large-scale excavations of medieval sites, which were mostly conducted in towns during the past few decades. The processing state in most of them is unsatisfactory, so it is still necessary to search for ways to their meaningful utilization and to try to identify the obstacles which archaeologists encounter in this work. The methodical level will be one of the partial conference topics. It will undoubtedly be interesting to find out, how individual institutions approach the processing of excavation results and which publishing outputs they produce in this regard. We cordially welcome all contributions addressing the significance of these excavations and their impact on the increase in knowledge about history of Central Europe.
