The conference aims to discuss the following issues:

How did people spent their spare time in the post-medieval period? Who could afford to enjoy their spare time? And – most importantly – how did this reflect upon pottery products? The main topics to be addressed:

- a) Toys and joys ceramic toys and spare time items
- b) Little big vices tobacco smoking and drinking and carousing
- c) Hidden garden treasures flowerpots and other garden ceramic
- d) Ancient laboratories ceramic distillation vessels
- e) Warming beauty spare time motifs on stove tiles

Papers on the above topics will be considered. The conference will be hosted in English. Both oral presentations (max. 20 min) as well as posters must be prepared in English.
