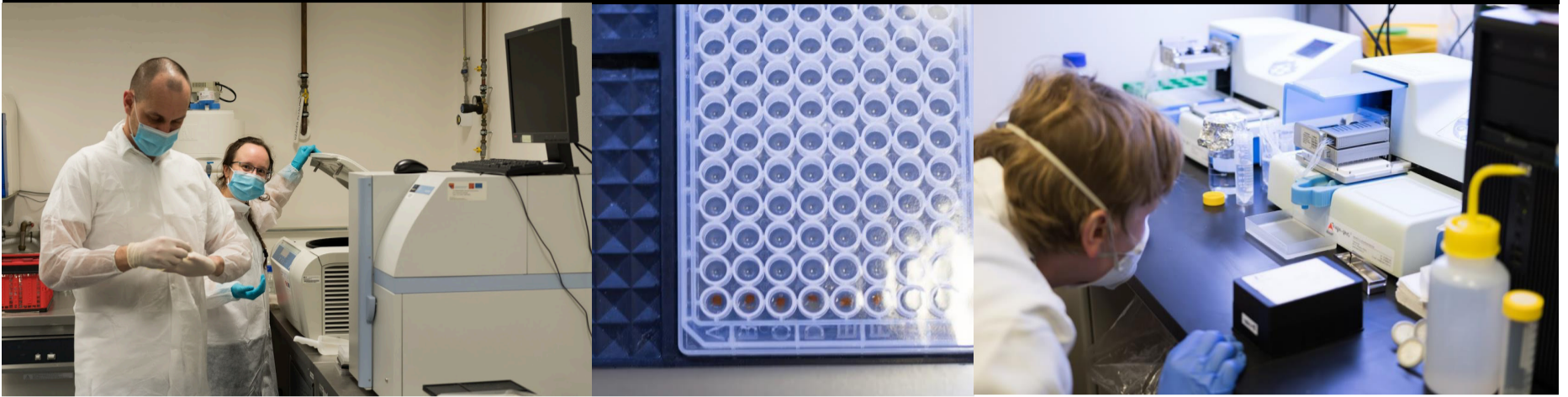
The samples came and it is necessary to change into the anti infectious dress code: the protective shield, the respirator, two layers of the protecting coats, the gloves and the determined poker face.
