### **Abstract of the lecture:**

This presentation will first shortly recall the concept of ERC, which was established more than a decade ago. It will focus on the ERC mission and how it has been put into reality. Then we will concentrate on the consequences for science in the Czech Republic. In particular, we will examine the questions whether and why the Czech presence within ERC should substantially change and how to improve the quality of the submitted proposals.
