The Making of the Majdanek Documentary Film in 1944

Natascha Drubek (Freie Universität Berlin)

The first Allied film recordings in a liberated German camp were made in July-August 1944 in Lublin/Majdanek by filmmakers embedded in the Soviet Army. Among them were several “flight survivors” who had escaped from Hitler-occupied Poland towards the east, and now were returning to their home country. Together with their Soviet colleagues they filmed the camp, and the extensive film material was sent to Moscow. A film was edited and screened in the end of November 1944 to Polish audiences. The talk, based on the monograph "Filme über Vernichtung und Befreiung" (published by Springer in 2020), will analyse the challenge of representing Jewish victims in the film.
