The research continues to work on identification of age-specific mechanisms leading to development of epilepsy and psychiatric co-morbidities of epilepsy in immature brain (*Kubova et al, J Neurosci, 2001; Mikulecka et al, Exp Neurol, 2019; Bencurova et al., Sci Rep, 2021; Bencurova et al, Neurobiol Dis, 2022*). The research project involves work with animal models of early onset epilepsy and offers unique possibility to learn unique methods of work with immature rats.
