Researcher in the Department of 19th-Century Literature

Members of this department carry out research on Czech literature from the period starting in the second half of the 18th century and extending to the beginning of the 20th century, in both Czech and European contexts. They also prepare scholarly editions of primary and secondary texts.

We are now looking to fill one new research position in the department.

Job description:

- Active scholarly work in the field, participation in grant projects, and other research tasks within the department
- Individual research in the field of Czech literature of the 19th century in both Czech and European contexts
- Publication of scholarly papers, participation in conferences in the field, and popularization/outreach activities
- Archival research

Minimum requirements:

- Masters degree or higher in the field of Czech literary studies (preferred) or other related field; at a minimum, doctoral studies in progress
- General understanding of 19th-century Czech literature in Central European contexts and of contemporary literary theory
- Published work in the field
- Experience with collective literary studies projects (preferred)
- Proficiency with PC computer, and with MS Word and other Office programs
- Working knowledge of Czech, English, and German, and possibly other languages

We offer:

- The context of the largest workplace in the field of scholarly Czech literary studies
- 25 days of vacation + 3 days of sick leave
- Allowance for meals and allowance from the Social Fund (supplementary pension insurance, Flexi Pass)
- Language courses
